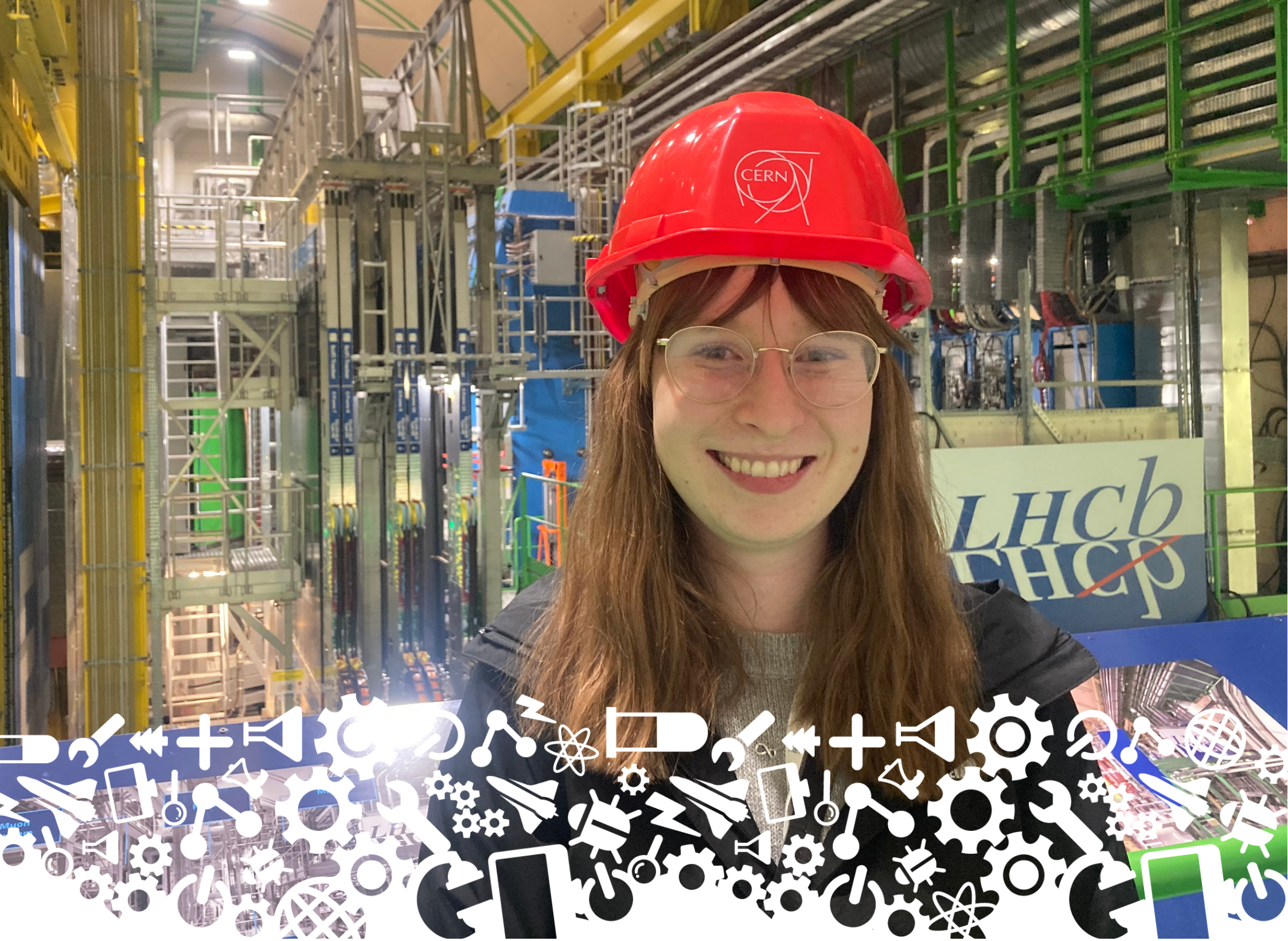




STEM PERSON
